



FLECTOR 180 mg medicated plaster
Diclofenac hydroxyethylpyrrolidine

1. What FLECTOR is and what it is used for

Flector contains the active substance diclofenac hydroxyethylpyrrolidine and it belongs to a class of medicines reducing pain and inflammation called non steroidal anti-inflammatory drugs (NSAIDs).

Flector is applied to the skin and it acts against pain and inflammation of joints, muscles, tendons and ligaments resulting from injuries or rheumatic diseases.

3. How to use FLECTOR

Adults over 18 years of age

The usual dose is 1 or 2 medicated plasters daily, every 12 or 24 hours, for a maximum of 14 days.

The plaster should be used whole.

Talk to a doctor if you not feel better or if you feel worse after 14 days of treatment.

Adolescents over 16 years of age

Talk to a doctor if you not feel better or if you feel worse after 7 days of treatment.

Children and adolescents under 16 years of age

Do not use Flector in children and adolescents under 16 years of age

Method of administration of the medicated plaster

Flector plaster is applied to the skin (cutaneous use).

- Cut the sachet containing the plasters and take a plaster
- Remove the protection film covering the adhesive side of the plaster
- Apply the whole plaster on the concerned area. If needed, the plaster may be secured by the elastic net supplied with the pack. Do not cover the area with plastic material or air-tight (occlusive) bandage.
- Close the sachet carefully.

6. CONTENTS OF THE PACK AND OTHER INFORMATION

What FLECTOR contains

The active substance is diclofenac hydroxyethylpyrrolidine

Each medicated plaster contains: 180 mg of diclofenac hydroxyethylpyrrolidine (equivalent to 140 mg of diclofenac sodium).

What FLECTOR looks like and contents of the pack

This medicine is a self-adhesive medicated plaster covered by a protective film supplied in packs of:

- 5 plasters in one sachet
- 8 plasters in two sachets with 4 plasters each;
- 10 plasters in two sachets with 5 plasters each;
- 15 plasters in three sachets with 5 plasters each;

Each pack is supplied with an elastic net band.
Not all pack sizes may be marketed.
