1. What Flectorartro 1% gel is and what is used for

Flectorartro 1% gel contains the active ingredient diclofenac epolamine, which is a type of medicine called a non-steroidal anti-inflammatory drug.

Flectorartro 1% gel is intended to be used in local symptomatic relief of pain and inflammation due to post-traumatic injuries, such as contusions, sprains and tendinitis.

3. How to use Flectorartro 1% gel

The product is to be applied on the skin, in adults and adolescents over 15 years of age only. Depending on the size of the affected site to be treated, 2-4g should be applied 2 to 4 times a day for a maximum of two weeks. After application, the hands should be washed unless they are the site being treated.

Flectorartro 1% gel can be used with non-occlusive bandages but should not be used with an airtight occlusive dressing.

6. Contents of the pack and other information

What Flectorartro 1% gel contains

The active substance is diclofenac epolamine.

100g of gel contain 1g of diclofenac sodium as diclofenac epolamine.

What Flectorartro 1% gel looks like and content of the pack

This medicinal product is presented as a white to white ivory gel, either in aluminium tube or in pressurized container. Each tube contains 50, 60 or 100g of gel while the pressurized container contains 100g of gel.

Not all pack sizes may be marketed.
